### AT THE OCT. 27<sup>TH</sup> BOARD MEETING

**President, Ryan Johnson** called the meeting to order at 7:44 PM. There were 11 board members present. **Youth President, Evan Hart** and **Board Member, Richard Shusterman** and **Vice President, Bill Hurja** were absent. **Recording Secretary, Lyle Okamoto** read the minutes of the Wednesday, October 8, 2008 General Meeting. The minutes were approved as read. **Treasurer, Ray Johnson** reported on the club's financial status. A total of \$822 has been spent on the gold prizes for the November meeting. The American Legion Hall has been paid up through the end of 2008. A check for \$195.58 was given to Cupertino Coin Club for San Jose's half of the picnic expenses. **Ray** gave **Al Lo** a bill for \$109.95, Cupertino's share of the cost of keys for the cases he purchased from San Jose/Cupertino Coin Clubs. **Ray** also received \$95 from **Lyle Okamoto** for miscellaneous medal sales. **Historian, Sally Johnson** received the 2008 obverse and reverse photo proofs and the 2009 reverse photo proof from **Lyle Okamoto**. **Medals Chair, Gordon Stubbs** reported that he will check with **Lee Kuntz**, of Masterpiece Medallions about our medal order. **Gordon** still needs to order the silver to strike our silver medals. He will try to get our order completed by the end of November. **Gordon** will also look into recycling our inventory of old copper and bronze medals. **News letter Editor, Ray Johnson** reported that 60 people are now receiving their newsletters by e-mail. **Web Master, Sally Johnson** reported that the club web site has received almost 13,800 hits. It is current, with November's list of gold raffle prizes and list of updated show information. Corresponding Secretary, **Al Lo** received the usual club newsletters, a bank statement, an information packet for the Santa Clara Expo Show and a CSNA ballot. A discussion took place on which CSNA candidates to vote for. After candidates, **Al Lo** and **Ron Ishizaki** left the room, the board voted for the uncontested

officers and made its choices on the contested positions.

**Old Business:** **Sally Johnson** noted that we need to update the club's bylaws. She handed out a new Web Master definition and a discussion followed about the Web Master's responsibilities. **Ray Johnson** made it clear that he did not want the Web Master to be responsible for web site security because it would seem that the Web Master alone would be responsible, which is not the case. **Board Member, Ron Ishizaki** made a motion to accept Sally's Web Master definition. Board Member, **Martha Davis** seconded. The motion passed. The Web Master description and the name change from Junior Vice-President to Youth President will appear in the next two newsletters and be voted on at the December General Meeting. **New Business:** none

**Show Business:** **Bourse Chair, Ray Johnson** reported that 56 dealers have signed up so far. A total of 28 corner tables and 32 straight tables have been sold. We also have a couple of new advertisers in our show program. **Club President, Ryan Johnson** has reset all of the show chair responsibilities. Members can volunteer for show chair jobs on a first come - first served basis. **Ryan** will be signing workers up at the November General Meeting. **Rich Medefesser** will be the Electrical Chair. Show admission will be \$3 or free with an advertisement. We will check with Fairground Security about wheelchair availability. **Keith Scott** suggested that we use a sandwich board showing other local coin shows and coin clubs. No action was taken on **Keith's** suggestion. **Lyle Okamoto** inquired about the advertising budget for our show. Since Advertising Chair **Richard Shusterman** was absent, the discussion was limited. The board, however, suggested that we cut down on display advertising expenses and mailing out fewer postcards. Some people have been on our mailing list for ten years without attending our show. The use of e-mail instead of mailed postcards also was suggested. **Al Lo** made a motion for adjournment. The meeting was adjourned at 9:19 PM.

## **BYLAWS UPDATES**

Every now and then our club bylaws need to be changed or updated. The board has approved one change and one addition to our current bylaws.

1. (*The Addition*) Shall the following job description of the San Jose Coin Club Webmaster be adopted and included into the club by-laws?

The **webmaster** (feminine: **webmistress**), also called the system administrator, the author, or the website administrator, is the person responsible for the designing, developing, marketing, or maintaining a website for the San Jose Coin Club. Core responsibilities of the webmaster include the regulation and management of access rights of different users of a web site, the appearance and setting up website navigation. Content placement can be part of a webmaster's responsibilities; typically, the webmaster is the agent who reads user feedback and complaints about the site functionally.

2. (*The Change*) Shall the title, **Junior Vice President** be changed to **Youth President**?

Members will be asked to vote on these two items at the December General Meeting.

For several years the San Jose Coin Club has benefited from the Santa Clara Coin, Stamp and Collectibles Expo's generosity. In November, 2003 we asked the show management if we could sell table raffle tickets where the dealers could win some or all of their bourse fees at their next show. Sales days are Friday and Saturday. The drawing is held at 4 PM on Saturday. So far, **the club has raised \$3668** selling these tickets.
