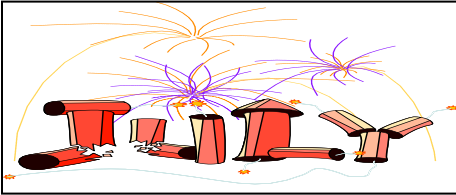

### From the Board Meeting on June 25, 2012

- Call to order by President Bill M. at 7:31 pm.

- Welcome 16 Board Members- President Bill M.; VP Gordon Stubbs; Recording Secretary Allison Paker; Corresponding Secretary Lyle Okamoto; Treasurer Sally Johnson; Immediate Past President Martha D.; Historian Ryan Johnson; Librarian Ed Sins; Curator Bill Hu.; Bourse Chair Ray Johnson; Board Members Steve Kooij, Fred Davis, Herb Davidson, Keith Scott, Brian Daniels; and Hall of Fame Member Ken Barr
- Recording Secretary Allison Paker waived reading the general meeting minutes. Steve Kooij seconded.
- Corresponding Secretary Lyle Okamoto had the usual club newsletters plus letters from the DMV, the IRS, FTD, and a letter for Ed Sins.
- Treasurer Sally Johnson gave her report. The rent on the hall and the fee for the post office box has gone up.
- Curator Bill Hu. will meet with Ken Barr and Bill M. after the meeting to set up a time to get the safety deposit box switched over. Bill M. would like an inventory completed before he signs for a key.
- Historian Ryan Johnson has pictures of Chuck Call presenting from the June general meeting.
- Program Chair Gordon Stubbs reports July is Youth Night. Ray Johnson is speaking on Native American Money.
- Medals Chair Gordon Stubbs passed out a worksheet titled 2013 Medals Cost. He went over the worksheet and reports the price for the silver medals works out to \$40 a medal, golden bronze works out to \$5.50, and copper works out to \$5.50. A set of golden bronze and copper would cost \$10. Ed Sins moved to accept the prices and Herb Davidson seconded. The motion passed. The issue of paying tax on medals was discussed.
- Youth Chair Sally Johnson reports Youth Night/Hot Dog Night is in July. Ray is speaking on wampum money.
- Picnic Chair Keith Scott reports the picnic is in progress. Martha D. has the reserved sign for the park. Keith will be getting the food. Lyle Okamoto has the prizes. Ray asked if Keith and Lyle's jobs would switch next year. Lyle reports 18 people have paid so far.
- Banquet- Bill M. reports Ron Ishizaki has declined Banquet Chair for 2013 so the position is still open. Ron is willing to work with the new chair to help them transition.
- Librarian Ed Sins still needs a Telephone Book 1701-1800. He is going to send out letters to people who have had books checked out for more than six months to try to get the books returned.
- Membership Ed Sins only received renewals this month. He had new updated copies of the membership list. Copies were given to President Bill M., Treasurer Sally Johnson, and Recording Secretary Allison Paker. Ed will be sending out letters to past due members. Ed asked for clarification that auction consignors must be bodily present. Ray answered that it is in the rules that consignors must be at the meeting. Gordon asked if there were any 50-year members this year. Ed reports Don & Jean Pritchett are 50-year members.
- Webmaster Sally Johnson reports we have 23,514 hits which is up 142 from last month. Everything has been updated.

- Old Business- a) Fred Davis has not been able to get a hold of the winner of the Harry Chapin medal from the November general meeting raffle. The medal is considered unclaimed and reverts to the club. It was given to Bill Hu. to be entered in the auction as a club donation. b) Sally Johnson has purchased a 10x10 canopy tent. It cost \$216.49. It can zip up the sides for cold weather and has a holder on wheels. She will now get bids to place the SJCC logo on the sides. c) Gordon confirmed we bought Martha D.' boxes for the Presidential Awards. Sally received the bill for the extra boxes and it's been paid. d) Fred has been trying to get a hold of Meghan Beltran as back-up for picking up the trailer from Lockheed. Fred asks if anyone has her phone number or e-mail, it would be helpful. e) Sally Johnson reports that due to corporate law, no last name initials can be in minutes. f) Ray will turn in the books for audit at the next meeting. He will also have a summary sheet for expenses at the next board meeting.
- New Business- a) Martha D. suggested kids get a special show & tell prize. It was discussed. Sally does already give kids at the meetings a nice coin. b) Bill M. will announce the next month's speaker at each general meeting. c) Bill M. appointed Steve Kooij Show & Tell Chair. d) Ken Barr received a very generous donation from Don Lynch at San Jose Coin Shop. Sally volunteered herself & Ryan. Ken still needs to get everything sorted first. e) Sally reports Joseph Schauf has passed away.
- Show Business- a) Bourse Chair Ray Johnson sent out bourse apps June 11 and received 21 back. Many dealers want larger tables. b) Fred Davis reports *Numismatic News* has an ad running on page 21. Ray said there are 2 more ads in the magazine. Richard Shusterman is getting the information out about our show. c) Brian Daniels suggested using a different tape for keeping electrical wires down. Our Electrician Rich Medefesser had to get better tape from the hotel at the 2012 show. Brian also mentioned the sandwich board signs need repairing. Ray answered it has been discussed. d) Ken Barr has a 1891S Liberty \$20 gold piece as a grand prize for the show raffle. He also has 2 1/10 ounce golds. He asked if the club wants the Liberty coin or would rather have a saint. It was discussed and the club will keep the Liberty coin. It was given to Gordon Stubbs. e) Sally has ordered 4000 raffle tickets. They should come in tomorrow. f) Fred asked about the club helping at Scott Griffin's Expo Show.
