From the Board Meeting on July 23, 2012

- Call to order by President Bill M. at 7:32pm.
- Welcome President Bill M., Vice President Gordon Stubbs, Recording Secretary Allison Paker, Corresponding Secretary Lyle Okamoto, Treasurer Sally Johnson, Historian Ryan Johnson, Librarian Ed Sins, Bourse Chair Ray Johnson, Immediate Past President Martha D., Board Members Steve Kooij, Fred Davis, Herb Davidson, Dean Birge, Keith Scott
- Recording Secretary Allison Paker waived reading the general meeting minutes. Steve Kooij seconded. Ray Johnson reminded everyone that we had previously agreed that the reading of general meeting minutes would always be waived as well as not giving a Treasurer's Report at the general meeting.
- Corresponding Secretary Lyle Okamoto had the usual mail plus a letter from Second Harvest Food Bank and a returned newsletter from Elsie Coriell.
- Treasurer Sally Johnson gave her report.
- Historian Ryan Johnson took pictures of the speaker at the July meeting.
- Program Chair Gordon Stubbs reports August is Other Hobbies Night.
- Picnic Chair Keith Scott reports the picnic went well. There were 36 adults and 2 youths. Keith reported improvements over previous picnics in that the food was ready on time, there was fewer leftovers, and the buffet was more orderly. There was plenty of food and drinks for everyone. Fred reported Keith did an excellent job with the shopping, cooking, and planning. Everyone gave Keith a round of applause.
- Banquet- Bill M. reports Brian Daniels will be the new banquet chair.
- Youth Chair Sally Johnson reports there were two youth for Youth Night. They received beads to make wampum. Fred asked where the Hiawatha Belt was located. Ray responded that it's at Iroquois Headquarters. Martha mentioned the belt is on one of the Native American dollars.
- Webmaster Sally Johnson reports we have 23,681 hits which is up 167 from last month. Everything has been updated. Bill M. asked when we get the most hits. Sally responded usually before our show and the Santa Clara show.

- Old Business- a) Martha D. still has Presidential Sets for the Beltrans. She will keep them one more month before giving the medals back to Gordon Stubbs. b) Herb Davidson asked how to pay the club back for his milkshake mistakenly placed on the club's drink receipt at the last board meeting. Ray said Herb should make a \$2 donation to the club.
- Membership Chair Ed Sins had renewal money for Treasurer Sally Johnson. Ed got a good response from his mail-outs of past due letters. He has not heard from 13 people. Ray asked if Ed knew Elsie Coriell and what her address might be. Ed only has the same address that the returned newsletter came from.
- New Business- a) Ray Johnson recently attended a Cupertino Club meeting and noticed that at least half of the auction slips were San Jose Coin Club's with San Jose crossed out and Cupertino written in. Both Martha and Keith said it is individual people taking several San Jose slips and using them at Cupertino. Ray asked that it be brought to Cupertino's board and Fred said that it would. b) Treasurer Sally Johnson stressed importance of everyone filling out forms correctly whether to turn in money or seek reimbursement for better tractability and accountability. Martha confirmed the IRS requires such documentation. Sally is creating a new spreadsheet that will specify where money is going. Non-profit rules were discussed. Martha suggested Sally scan receipts for back-up. Sally responded she and Ryan have looked into that. Ray said a problem comes from people requesting reimbursement without receipts. c) Ray Johnson wondered about Cupertino Coin Club's interest in the extra Presidential Set boxes Martha had. Martha answered CCC wasn't interested. Ray asked if the boxes required Air-Tites. Martha didn't remember the insert brand. Sally suggested buying more inserts from Paul at Scott-Western.
- Show Business- a) Bourse Chair Ray Johnson reports we have 43 dealers so far. Ray estimates we will sell out. We have 70 tables available. Many dealers are asking for larger tables. b) Ray needs someone to tow the trailer from Lockheed to the show. It requires a heavy duty truck or SUV. Ed suggested hiring the job out. Ray has someone else in mind he can ask first. It was discussed. Gordon asked what the trailer and its contents weighed and suggested running the trailer over a truck scale. c) Fred asked about Scott Griffin's show. Sally answered that we will sell dealers raffle tickets with a first prize of \$250 off next bourse table and a second prize of \$100 off a future bourse table. Raffle ticket prices were discussed.
- Sally moved and Martha seconded for adjournment at 8:24 pm.

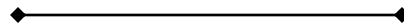
