From the Board Meeting on October 22, 2012

- Call to Order by President Bill M. at 7:39 pm.
- Welcome 11 Board Members & 1 guest- President Bill M.; Vice President Gordon Stubbs; Recording Secretary Allison Paker; Corresponding Secretary Lyle Okamoto; Librarian Ed Sins; Immediate Past President Martha D.; Bourse Chair Ray Johnson; Historian Ryan Johnson; Board Members- Steve Kooij, Herb Davidson, Brian Daniels; and guest- Advertising Chair Richard Shusterman
- President Bill M. thanked Vice President Gordon Stubbs for conducting the previous board meeting.
- Recording Secretary- The issue of reading the board meeting minutes at the general meeting was discussed. Ed Sins said it is in the Constitution that decisions of the board must be read at the general meeting. Allison Paker read the section from the Constitution. Ed suggested just reading the decisions of the board at the general meeting instead of the entire meeting minutes and the board agreed.
- Corresponding Secretary Lyle Okamoto had the usual mail. We also received a letter from the ANA with a new program for local clubs to give a powerpoint presentation to law enforcement organizations to help with numismatic crime. Ed spoke on the difficulty of proving numismatic crimes.
