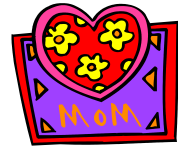
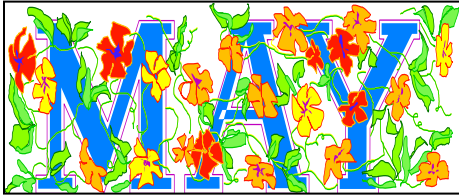

## New Constitutional Amendment!

A new amendment to the constitution has been proposed. The amendment must appear in writing for two months before being voted on at the general meeting. This is the second month the amendment has appeared in writing. The amendment will change Article VIII, Section 12 which now reads: "The Board of Directors upon call of the president shall take up for consideration and recommendation, all matters or questions for the betterment or improvement of the club, and shall handle all complaints that may arise from any source. Acceptance of the minutes of the Board's meetings, read before the club, shall constitute the approval by the club of their recommendations. The Board shall vote on all applications for membership."

Amendment 33 reads "In Article VIII, Section 12 add 'In the interest of time, the Recording Secretary may read at the general meeting just the decisions, i.e. motions, made at the Board meeting.'"

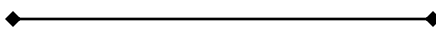
